Some Key Points in Mark Chapter 9

Mark 9: 2-13, Exodus 24: 15-18, 2 Kings 2: 9-12 See who I am.

- After the disciples, or at least Peter, realised who Jesus was, Jesus appeared to Peter, James, and John as he had been and would be one day in glory.
- The dazzling white of his clothing is typical in the Bible of heavenly beings and angels.
- Elijah and Moses clearly represent the OT hope of God's Kingdom.
- As at Sanai the cloud is a symbol of God's presence.
 Moses and Elijah fade away and only Jesus is left. The ONLY way to God.
- The words from God are clear, and again the disciples are warned to not reveal this to anyone until after Jesus' death.
- They could not fully understand what that meant, to
 us it now seems obvious, but they may have taken
 it simply as they had seen with Jarius daughter. They
 could not fully comprehend what was to come.
